OPTION 2: Historic Spanish Point w/ SUP/Kayak
Sarasota

9:30a – 12:30p (Bring your lunch) \$55/pp*Single kayak or SUP; \$75/tandem kayak
Kayak/SUP tour at Historic Spanish Point. It is a special paddle, amongst mangroves and the
Bird Keys in Little Sarasota Bay with a visit to the original Mote Marine Shark Tank, which
was an enclosure at Midnight Pass that has now been reclaimed and surrounded by
mangroves, and a short hop/portage over a dune to the Gulf for a swim at isolated Midnight
Pass Beach, not accessible by car. We have tandem or single kayaks and SUPs that depart
from the historic Guptil House at HSP. There are opportunities to bring lunch or picnic at HSP
if desired. We recommend that you wear water shoes (lots of shells and some oyster bed
areas), sunscreen, and something to drink during the tour. For reservations, payment, or

Come explore the wonder of Conservation Foundation of the Gulf Coast's Bay Preserve at Osprey. Provided by FL SEE Platinum Certified Around the Bend Nature Tours and Conservation Foundation staff, participate in a behind the scenes tour of the property and capture a glimpse of Old Florida at this oasis on Little Sarasota Bay. Discover the bounty of the estuary in the grass flats: join Around the Bend Nature Tours as we wade in and net in the seagrass beds, identify the critters, then release them. Closed toed shoes that can get wet are required (we do have some to loan). Rare critters occasionally captured: pygmy seahorse and keys eel. Lunch inside the historic home on the bay is provided.
